


# Using Klinck Memorial Library Databases

Here you will find three convenient links that provide access to databases. **EBSCO Gateway** delivers a wide selection of databases. **ProQuest Gateway** provides access to ebooks and databases. **WorldCat Discovery** serves as a portal to handy library links, including library catalogs and databases. You can also access a wider selection by simply choosing the **DATABASES** column.

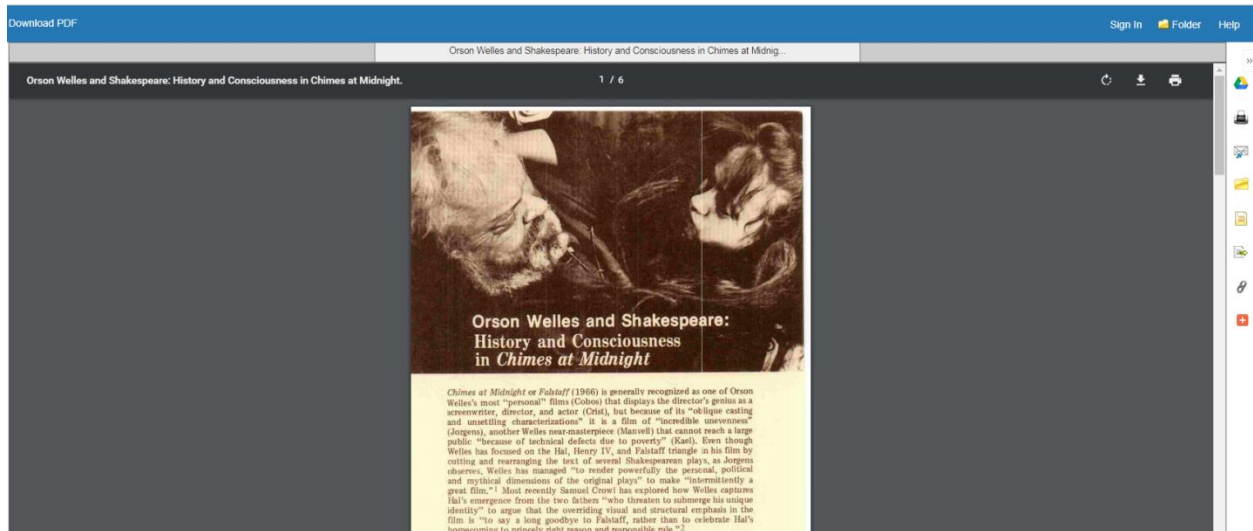
