

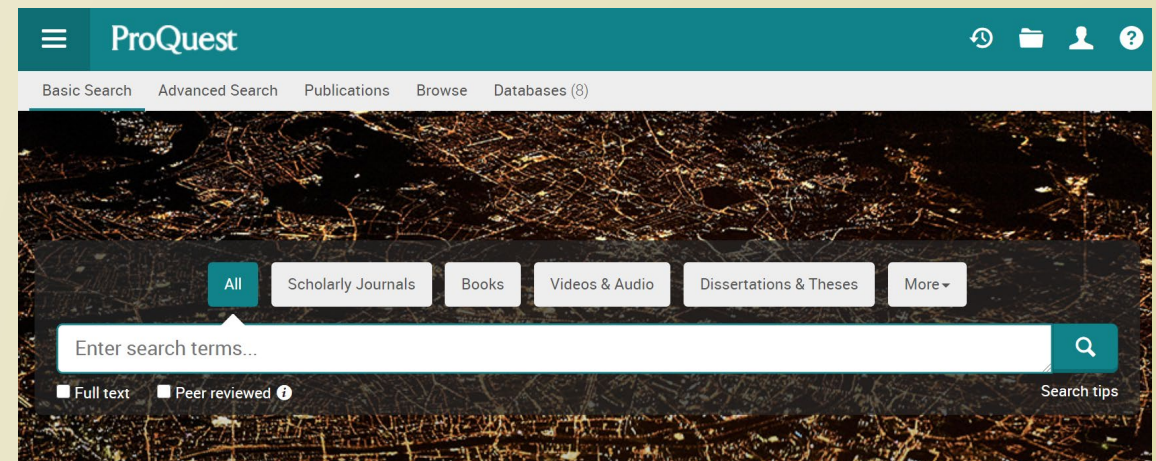
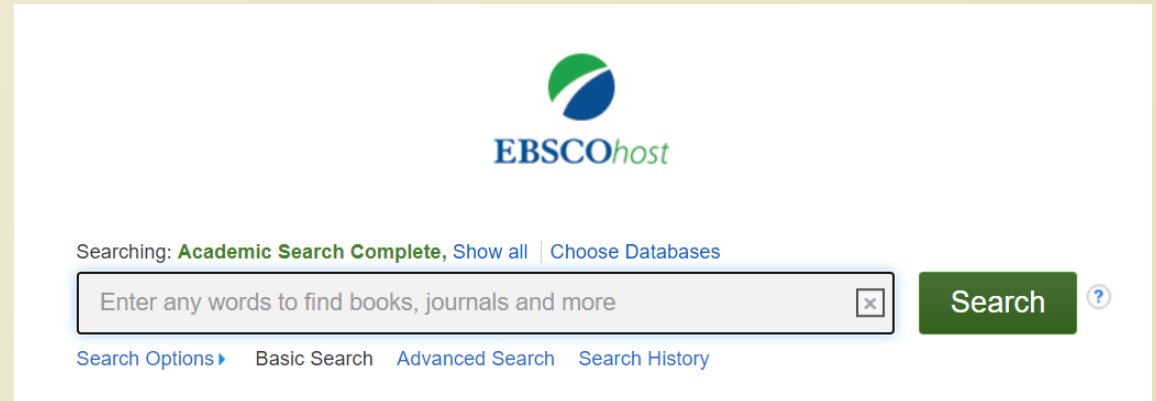

Delivery of Journal Articles

To request journal articles not found in the [Library Catalog](#), complete an [Interlibrary Loan Request](#). Journal articles are delivered to borrowers via e-mail, mail or fax.

Delivery of Books, Dissertations and AV Materials to Out-of-State Students

Since you are off campus, it is important for you to check out your local public, academic, or research libraries before submitting delivery requests to the Klinck Memorial Library. This may reduce turnaround time.

Before requesting dissertations, search the [ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global](#). To request dissertations not found in the ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global database, books, and AV materials, complete an [Interlibrary Loan Request](#).

Materials can be delivered to borrowers and returned to the Klinck Memorial Library via mail. Borrowers are responsible for return postage and for materials lost in the mail.

Request renewals by [email](#) and phone 708-209-3050 or toll free 866-733-8287. Items recalled by other patrons may not be renewed.

Delivery of Books, Dissertations and AV Materials to In-State Students

Before requesting dissertations, search the [ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global](#) database. To request books, dissertations, and AV materials not found in [I-Share](#) or the [ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global](#) database, complete an [Interlibrary Loan Request](#). These materials are available for pick-up at the Klinck Memorial Library. They can also be delivered to borrowers via mail. Borrowers are responsible for return postage and for materials lost in the mail.

Log in to your account in the [Library Catalog](#) to renew items from [I-Share](#). Borrowers may also request renewals by [email](#) and phone 708-209-3050 or toll free 866-733-8287. Items recalled by other patrons may not be renewed.
