


Online Business Resources

The following tutorial provides a basic introduction to business databases and full text journal subscriptions available through the Klinck Memorial Library website.

The library has access to over 100 databases. To narrow your search for business databases, click on the Databases link on the library homepage.

On the Research Databases page, select Business. The list includes our current subscriptions.

Full text articles can also be found through the Concordia Journals tab of the Library Catalog. To limit your search for all the titles available under a particular subject, you can use “Journals by category”. Select Business & Economics.
