My setting of the *O Antiphons* came about because of a conversation I had with my school's pastor, Rev. Jacob Ehrhard. At our last chapel before Christmas vacation in 2022, we created a service where select students read the traditional *O Antiphons* text and an Old Testament reading followed by the congregation responding with the corresponding verse of the hymn, *O Come, O Come, Emmanuel*. He thought it would be worthwhile to find a musical setting that utilized the *O Antiphons* text for St. John's 3rd-8th grade Christmas program for December of 2023. I decided that I should be the one to compose it.

On December 10th, 2023, the 3rd-8th grade students from St. John's Lutheran School in Chicago, IL performed this setting of the *O Antiphons*. The only adult musicians were the flute player and some of the hand chime players. Every other part was performed by a grade-school student. They took this task very seriously and enjoyed sharing this unique blend of ancient and modern combined to share the good news of the birth of their Savior.

The following Biblical texts were read before each movement. Each selection includes a Messianic promise from the Old Testament and the fulfillment of that promise through the birth, life, and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. After each Antiphon was sung, the congregation responded with the corresponding hymn verse.

The first text was read after the Prelude to Antiphon 1.


