Conductor DR. MAURICE
C. BOYER is professor
of music at Concordia
University Chicago,
where he conducts the
Chamber Orchestra and
the chapel choir (Schola
Cantorum). Dr. Boyer
also teaches aural skills

as well as interdisciplinary courses in the Honors curriculum. Dr. Boyer is music director of the American Kantorei of Saint Louis, MO, and associate conductor of the Symphony of Oak Park and River Forest. He has been artistic director of Aestas Consort and the Heritage Chorale.

Although born in the United States, Dr.
Boyer began his musical training (piano, voice and solfège) in Aix-en-Provence,
France, where he lived until the age of 18.
He holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in orchestral conducting from the University of Maryland, College Park. His Master of Music is in choral conducting and his Bachelor of Music in sacred music (with

piano as his principal instrument). Both were earned at Westminster Choir College of Rider University in Princeton, NJ. His principal conducting teachers have been Joseph Flummerfelt, Kenneth Kiesler and James Ross. He also studied theology at Princeton Theological Seminary.

Among Dr. Boyer's areas of sustained interest and research are the sacred choral works of J. S. Bach—historical performance practice and theology—and the symphonic music of Mozart, Mahler and Sibelius.
